outdoor pillows) and trims. In the near future, Campbell plans to expand to include a line of custom leather-wrapped photo albums and other home accessories.

Katie Kiyo, owner of Big Hug said, "This concept comes at a time when we are searching for alternate uses for digital photographs, and artistic ways of keeping memories alive.
